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UNDERSTANDING SEISMICITY CATALOG AND THEIR PROBLEMS IN ZAMBIA

Earthquake activity in Zambia is closely associated with the East Africa Rift system (EARS). Areas of earthquake activity in Zambia. Although in the rest of the areas in southern Africa seismicity is low, elsewhere in Zambia seismicity is more diffuse with possibilities of occurrence of earthquakes with magnitudes $M_s > 5.0$. Seismicity catalogues are one of the most important products of seismology they provide a comprehensive database used related to seismicity seismo-tectonics earthquake physics and seismic hazards analysis.
