- On-site Inspection (OSI) Integrated Field Exercises (IFE) provide an unrivalled platform to test various operational, procedural and technical elements of an in an integrated manner.
- The next IFE shall be designed to demonstrate maintenance of existing capabilities and newly developed elements, and will allow for the review of policy, operational, support, logistical and technical capabilities from a holistic, cross-cutting perspective.
- The next IFE is scheduled in 2026 and expected to be hosted by the Republic of Namibia. It will involve:
  - approximately 200 participants, over a period of up to seven weeks, and an inspection area approaching the Treaty-permitted 1000km<sup>2</sup>.
  - headquarters support provided from an Operations Support Centre (OSC) at the Vienna International Centre (VIC) and CTBTO Test Centre in Seibersdorf, Austria.
- Our poster provides information on the aim and objectives, locations and participants, planned exercise scope, scenario development process, cross-cutting issues includer health, safety and security and field communications, as well as the general status of the planning and preparation process.
